2017 Bills Restricting Women's Healthcare Rights

Defunding Planned Parenthood (HB 2264)

Restricts state and federal funding for women's health providers like Planned Parenthood. **60 Republicans vote YES; passed by House of Delegates**

"Day of Tears" Resolution

Makes the anniversary of Roe v. Wade a day of mourning in Virginia with lowered flags. **57 Republicans vote YES; passed by House of Delegates**

Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act (HB 1473)

Sought to criminalize abortion at 20 weeks. **Bill Co-Patrons: Dudenhefer, Lingamfelter, Hugo, Massie**


